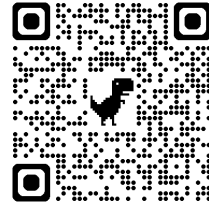

Verizon Tower Update- as of 06/01

Our Administrative council and Finance Team met in a joint meeting on Monday, June 1st to discuss the progress of the proposed cell phone tower. We are still in negotiations with the team at Vertical Bridge (the people who would build the tower). The proposed monthly income will be \$1,600 per month with an annual escalation of 1.5% each year. We also have 3 more opportunities to earn additional funds up to \$32,000, if Vertical Bridge allows another carrier to use the tower. These are one-time payouts that do not affect our monthly income from Vertical Bridge. We are also discussing the possibility of a different location for the tower here on the property, and will keep everyone updated as that information becomes available.
